Carefully lay the preassembled Desk Frame upside-down on a large flat surface. Using four Table Frame Screws per Leg, attach the legs to each angled opening in the Bracket. The legs should sprout outwards, opposite the eyelets.



Carefully lay the Desktop upside-down on a large flat surface. With a friend, place the assembled frame onto the desktop, aligning the frame eyelets to the desktop pilot holes. Use seven (twelve) Table Top Screws to affix the smaller (larger) top to the base. Use the pre-drilled holes on the corners of the desk to center and secure your desk to the base. The center screws are optional, and can be screwed directly into the desktop. 3



With help from a friend, grab the main frame of your desk and flip upright.

To install the in-desk power unit: Screw in the Power Unit using Screws under the Desktop following the four pre-drilled holes surrounding the cut out. Plug in the power cord to the wall—you're now all set!
